The Mary Edsal McLaughlin Award offers students and faculty an opportunity to follow their imagination through research and travel to experience something fresh and different - something that inspires creativity. The goal is to allow the recipient to experience a visual exploration of place and quality; curiosity and innovation; and people and place. The area of focus is up to YOU. There are no restrictions in what YOU want to see, research or experience. The award may cover travel, admission to museums, room & board.

This award is open to graduate students, undergraduate students of at least sophomore status, who have passed the portfolio review for continuation in their major, and all faculty.

Submit to the Dean of the College of Arts & Architecture - 217 Cheever Hall.

Awards of up to \$5,000 will be considered. You will be notified within 2-4 weeks of the decision.

Final Report Requirements - Once your 'adventure' has been completed, we ask that your findings, sketches, and photos be shared with the Dean's office in order to be forwarded to the McLaughlin Family. One of these artistic pieces will be displayed in the Dean's Gallery.
